PROJECTS

Instructions:

- 1 There are **three (3)** projects listed below. Choose **one (1)** project.
- 2 Follow the technological design process to do the write up and when making the chosen product.

(a) Weave window blinds

- (i) Use any suitable material in your environment (plastics, grasses or any other materials).
- (ii) Choose a weaving style.
- (iii) The size of the window blinds should be 1m by 50cm.
- (iv) Show creativity and good finishing.
- (v) Cost and prize the product.
- (vi) Make a poster to advertise the product.

(b) Stage a performance educating the community about COVID-19 awareness.

Prepare a script (with at least two scenes) that will be used to educate people about **COVID-19** awareness.

- (i) Select characters for the performance and assign roles.
- (ii) Organise a suitable costume for the main character.
- (iii) Choose and prepare a suitable stage for your performance.
- (iv) Collect musical instruments for accompaniment.
- (v) Rehearse and prepare for the public performance.
- (vi) Make a poster to advertise the performance.

(c) Carve a set of two cooking utensils (chopping board, wooden spoon, stirring pin, rolling pin, lujujo, etc)

Choose any available and appropriate wood for carving

- (i) Select a suitable carving technique for styling and shaping the product
- (ii) The product should be of regular size.
- (iii) Show creativity and good finishing.
- (iv) Cost and price the product.
- (v) Make a poster to advertise the product.
