#### **Practical Task: Planting fruit trees (four fruit trees)**

Candidates are to plant a fruit tree.

**Duration: one day** 

#### **OBJECTIVES:**

By the end of the practical the candidate must be able to:

- 1. Clear the land
- 2. Dig a planting hole for a fruit tree
- 3. Plant a fruit tree
- 4. Stake the fruit tree
- 5. Protect the fruit tree

#### Instructions:

- Collect all relevant tools and materials
- Clear the land
- Dig the planting hole
- Add compost; animal manure
- Add basal dressing fertiliser
- Mix properly the organic /inorganic fertilizer with the top soil
- Plant the fruit tree
- Stake the tree
- Protect it from damage

- o Peg for staking
- Material for protection (pegs/fence)
